2022 TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Schedule to Conditions of Entry

1. <u>Organiser:</u>	Nestlé Products Sdn. Bhd. [197901000966] [“the Organiser”].
2. <u>Challenge:</u>	NESTLÉ HARVEST GOURMET #HGEATGOODCHALLENGE 2022. [“Challenge”].
3. <u>Registration Period:</u>	The Challenge is open for registration from 00:00:00 on 9/11/2022 till 23:59:59 on 8/01/2023 [“Registration Period”]
4. <u>Registration Deadline:</u>	Registrations for the Challenge participation must be received by the Organiser on or before the end of the Registration Period at 23:59:59 on 8/01/2023. All registrations received outside the Registration Period will be automatically disqualified.
5. <u>Challenge Period:</u>	The Challenge will only commence and start at 00:00:00 on 10/12/2022 and closes at 23:59:59 on 8/01/2023 [“Challenge Period”]
6. <u>Eligibility:</u>	The Challenge is open to all Malaysian citizens and permanent residents residing in Malaysia with a valid identification document, aged 18 years old and above as at the start of the Challenge Period. The Organiser shall reserve the right to request for evidence of identification documents.
7. <u>Challenge Tasks:</u>	<p>The Challenge requires Participants to complete the following TWO (2) tasks (“Challenge Tasks”) during the Challenge Period:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">i) Participants must upload photos of at least 15 different sets of cooked meals incorporating use of HARVEST GOURMET plant-based products* as key ingredient (“HARVEST GOURMET Meals”) onto the #HGEatGoodChallenge platform using the BookDoc App; ANDii) Participants must complete and record and log at least 120,000 step count in the #HGEatGoodChallenge platform hosted on the BookDoc app. <p>* Note: HARVEST GOURMET plant-based products can be purchased from selected supermarkets or online stores listed in https://www.harvestgourmet.my/. HARVEST GOURMET plant-based products are currently not available in supermarkets and retail outlets</p>

in East Malaysia. Participants in East Malaysia can complete the 15 HARVEST GOURMET Meals challenge by purchasing and uploading photos of “F&B-cooked” HARVEST GOURMET Meals (refer to Task 1 (iii)).

TASK 1: UPLOADING OF PHOTOS OF HARVEST GOURMET MEALS

- i) The 15 photos uploaded may consist of either “home-cooked” **or** “F&B-cooked” HARVEST GOURMET Meals
- ii) For photos depicting “home-cooked” HARVEST GOURMET Meals**, **each** photo must:
- consist of a meal made with HARVEST GOURMET plant-based product as the key ingredient
 - show and display the product packaging of the HARVEST GOURMET plant-based product used to prepare the HARVEST GOURMET Meal;

- iii) For photos depicting “F&B-cooked” HARVEST GOURMET Meals, **each** photo must:
- consist of a meal prepared and cooked by any of the participating F&B restaurants and partners listed in https://www.harvestgourmet.my/sites/default/files/2022-11/F%26B_Vendors_Outlet_Lists.pdf;
 - be uploaded with the correct ‘Restaurant Name’ and ‘Meal Name’ selected at the submission page section;
 - be uploaded together with the official receipt issued by the participating F&B restaurant or partner from which the “F&B-cooked” HARVEST GOURMET Meal was ordered and purchased. The official receipt must be submitted via the ‘Receipt’ section;

TASK 2: LOGGING OF 120,000 STEP COUNT

- i) Complete and log a minimum total of 120,000 step count during the Challenge Period in the #HGEatGoodChallenge platform hosted on the BookDoc app.

13. Weekly Prizes

In addition to the Challenge Completion Entitlements, Participants may also stand a chance to win a weekly prize during the Challenge Period.

Week 2: 00:00:00, 17/12 – 23:59:59, 23/12/2022

Week 3: 00:00:00, 24/12 – 23:59:59, 30/12/2022

Week 4: 00:00:00, 31/12/2022 – 23:59:59, 8/01/2023

(Each a “Challenge Week”)

Throughout the Challenge Period and at the end of each Challenge Week, the Organiser will tabulate the total number of HARVEST GOURMET meals completed by the Participants and the HARVEST GOURMET Meal photos uploaded onto the #HGEatGoodChallenge platform using the BookDoc App.

Participants who have completed the number of meals as per the table below and verified to have met the Challenge Requirements for HARVEST GOURMET Meal photos, will stand a chance to win a weekly prize:

Number of Verified Meals by Week	Week 1	Week 2	Week 3	Week 4
Minimum Cumulative Total	3 meals	7 meals	11 meals	15 meals

Example: Number of Meals in Week 4 will be the total sum of Verified Meals from Week 1 to Week 3, with addition of new meals submitted and verified in Week 4, to achieve the Minimum Cumulative Total of 15 Verified Meals.

Verified Meal photos will be categorised by the Organiser as “Qualified Entry” based on the following:

- Minimum Cumulative Total 3 Verified Meals = 1 Qualified Entry for Weekly Prize in Week 1
- Minimum Cumulative Total 7 Verified Meals = 1 Qualified Entry for Weekly Prize in Week 2
- Minimum Cumulative Total 11 Verified Meals = 1 Qualified Entry for Weekly Prize in Week 3
- Minimum Cumulative Total 15 Verified Meals = 1 Qualified Entry for Weekly Prize in Week 4

For each Challenge Week, the Organiser has allocated the following weekly prizes to be won:

Shortlisting of Weekly Prize Winner

2. The serial numbers allocated to each Qualified Entry will be added up to derive the total number of Qualified Entries [“Total Qualified Entries”].
3. Assuming that the total number of Qualified Entries is 5000, the Organiser will compute and select the finalists [“Finalist”] to win the prizes based on the following:

i. Selection of one [1] Weekly Prize Winner: $5000 \div 5 = 1000$.

Challenge Finishers Lucky Draw: How to Enter

A set of serial numbers will be allocated for the Qualified Entries starting from serial number 1".
2. The serial numbers allocated to each Qualified Entry will be added up to derive the total number of Qualified Entries ["Total Qualified Entries"].
3. Assuming that the Qualified Entries is 5000, the Organiser will compute and select the finalists ["Finalist"] to win the prizes based on the following:

i. Selection of one [1] Grand Prize Finalists: $5000 \div 3 = 1666.67$.

Since dividing 5000 with 3 will result in a number with decimal value, the number 1666.7 will be rounded up to 1667. The number will be rounded to the nearest single digit number.

The shortlisted Grand Prize Finalist is the 1667th serial number Qualified Entry.

Shortlisting of 1st Runner Up

1. For Qualified Entries that have not won prizes in the Grand Prize draw will be accumulated and eligible for the 1st Runner Up draw. The Organiser will then allocate new serial numbers for remaining Qualified Entries. Assuming that the remaining Total Qualified Entries for the 1st Runner Up Prize draw is 4999 ($5000 - 1 = 4999$), the Organiser will compute and select the finalists ["Finalist"] to win the prize based on the following:

i. Selection of two [1] 1st Runner Up Prize Finalists: $4999 \div 3 = 1666.3$

Since dividing 4999 with 3 will result in a number with decimal value, the number 1666.3 will be rounded up to 1666. The number will be rounded to the nearest single digit number.

The shortlisted 1st Runner Up Finalist is the 1666th serial number Qualified Entry.

Shortlisting of 2nd Runner Up

1. For Qualified Entries that have not won any prizes in either the Grand Prize draw and 1st Runner Up draw will be accumulated and eligible for the to the 2nd Runner Up draw. The Organiser will then allocate new serial numbers for remaining Qualified Entries. Assuming that the remaining Total Qualified Entries for the 2nd Runner Up Prize draw is 4998 (5000 - 2 = 4998), the Organiser will compute and select the finalists ["Finalist"] to win the prize based on the following:

- i. **Selection of 2nd Runner Up Prize Finalists: $4997 \div 3 = 1665.7$**

Since dividing 4997 with 2 will result in a number with decimal value, the number 1665.7 will be rounded up to 1666. The number will be rounded to the nearest single digit number.

The shortlisted 2nd Runner Up Finalist is the 1666th serial number Qualified Entry.

The shortlisted Grand Prize, 1st Runner Up and 2nd Runner Up Finalists will be contacted via the mobile numbers provided during Challenge registration. Each Finalist will be given [1] question to answer. The shortlisted Finalists must answer the question posted by the Organiser correctly in order to the Prizes. Failure to answer correctly and/or failure to answer the question posted by the Organiser within the time stated will result in the Prize being forfeited. The Organiser will not be held liable in the event any of the shortlisted Finalists cannot be contacted for whatever reasons.

The Conditions of Entry and the Schedule to Condition of Entry shall collectively be referred to as the “Terms and Conditions”. Each capitalized term not otherwise defined herein shall have the meaning ascribed to such term in the Schedule to Conditions of Entry. Defined terms will be used singular or plural as the case may be.

1.2 The Organiser reserves the right in its sole discretion, without prior notice, and without any liability to any person, at any time to change the Terms and Conditions including to change the Challenge Period, make Prize substitutions, cancel, terminate or suspend the Challenge in whole or in part. In the event of any changes to the Terms and Conditions, Participants agree that their continued participation in the Challenge will constitute their acceptance of the Terms and Conditions (as changed).

1.3 The Organiser's decision on all matters relating to the Challenge including judging and selection of winners will be final, binding and conclusive on all Participants, and no correspondence or appeals will be entertained.

1.5 By submitting an entry to the Challenge, Participants are deemed to have understood and agreed to be bound by the Terms and Conditions.

2. Eligibility A

 - (b) are not eligible or unable to provide proof of eligibility to participate in the Challenge for verification by Organiser when requested.
- 4.3 In the event of a disqualification after a Prize has been awarded, the Organiser reserves the right to demand for the return of the Prize or payment of its value from the disqualified Participant.

5. Prizes

- 5.1 The Organiser, its agents, sponsors and representatives shall have no liability to any Participant who defaults in collecting the Prizes in accordance with the Prize Claim/Delivery Date in any respect whatsoever. Each Participant agrees to indemnify, release and hold harmless each of the Organiser, its holding, subsidiary or related companies as defined in the Companies Act 2016 ("Nestlé Malaysia Group"), directors, officers, employees, agents, sponsors and/or representatives against any and all losses, rights, claims, actions and damages (including special, indirect and consequential damages) arising from or incurred as a result of the Participant's participation in the Challenge, acceptance of any Prize, and/or the use of the Participant's entry and/or likeness in connection with the Challenge or violation of the Terms and Conditions,
